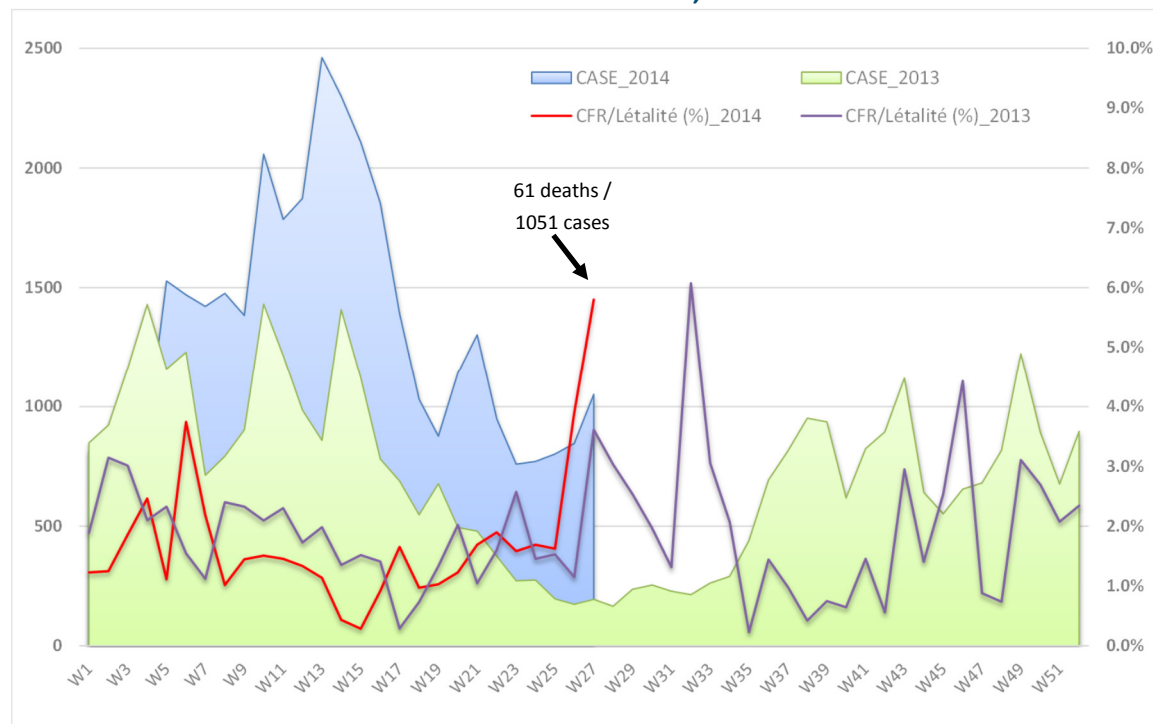

## Evènements au sujet du choléra dans la région

Un atelier bilan et de révision du plan de lutte cholera s'est tenu du 15 au 17 juillet à Tsévié au Togo. Le plan intègre la notion de ciblage de la réponse d'urgence d'après l'investigation du contexte de transmission et la cartographie des cas. Des actions durables sont planifiées dans les zones à haut risque.

Une réunion transfrontalière de lutte contre le choléra se tiendra à Tsévié les 22 et 23 Juillet. Les participants du Togo et du Bénin travailleront sur un cadre d'échange et sur une feuille de route pour la collaboration transfrontalière.

## Events on cholera in the region

A workshop to review the national plan against cholera outbreak was held from July 15<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> in Tsévié Togo. The plan incorporates the concept of driving the emergency response according to transmission context and cases mapping. Sustainable actions are planned in high-risk areas.

A cross-border meeting against cholera outbreak will take place in Tsévié on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> of July. Participants from Togo and Benin will work on an exchange framework and a roadmap for cross-border collaboration.

## COMMENTS



A noter que trois cas ont été enregistrés dans le district de Goulfey (21 Mai) et trois cas dans le district de Kousseri (29 juin), à la frontière avec N'Djamena. Le Tchad n'a pas encore enregistré de cas en 2014 mais le risque augmente avec les incursions le long de la frontière de plus en plus fréquentes.

The ongoing cholera outbreak in Cameroon has been aggravated with a tripling of the number of cases between week 25 and week 27. Transmission contexts predominant appear to be the transmission link with funeral rituals and the consumption of contaminated surface water (mayo).

The Far North region, located between Nigeria and Chad is the most affected area with 934 cases and 45 deaths (Let: 4.8%) registered as of 15<sup>th</sup> of July. The most affected districts are located at the border with Nigeria - Mogode (708cas/32dc), Bourha (96cas/6dc) and Hina (111cas/7dc). Note that three cases were registered in the district of Goulfey (May 21<sup>th</sup>) and three cases in the district of Kousseri (June 29<sup>th</sup>), at the border with N'Djamena. Chad has not registered cases yet in 2014 but the risk is increasing with incursions along the border becoming more frequent.

Entre le 02 et le 13 Juillet, 165 cas dont 7 décès de cholera ont été enregistrés au Benin. Les districts touchés (Toffo (127 cas/6 dc), Allada (27 cas/0 dc) et Zé (10 cas/1 dc)) appartiennent à la région Atlantique. L'extension de l'épidémie vers les régions Maritime et Lomé au Togo est à anticiper.

Between 02<sup>nd</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> of July, 165 cases with 7 deaths of cholera were registered in Benin. Affected districts - Toffo (127case/6death) Allada (27case/0death) and Zé (10case/1death) - belong to the Atlantique region. The extension of the outbreak to Lome and Maritime regions in Togo should be anticipated.
