

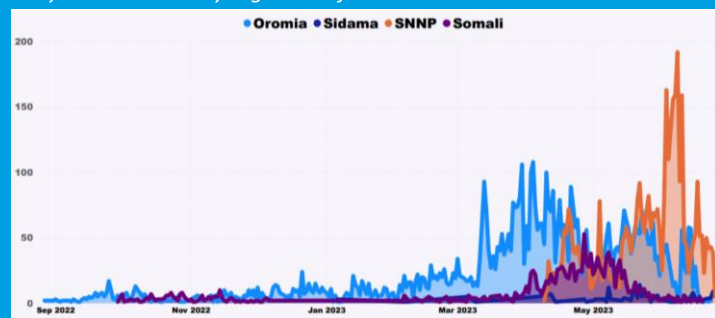
Cholera

Cases as of 25 June 2023	12,198
Weekly increase since 18 June 2023	791
Deaths	165
CFR	1.38% (-)
Woredas affected	73 (-)

Highlights

- Cholera cases reported in 73 woredas in 4 regions (Oromia, Somali, SNNP and Sidama). **No change in number of woredas or CFR.**
- **Isolated cholera case confirmed in Debere Birhan hospital (Amhara region)**, imported from cholera-affected woreda in Oromia. Efforts are ongoing to contain further spreading.
- **SNNP still reporting largest number of cases, albeit a decrease is observed (see graph)**

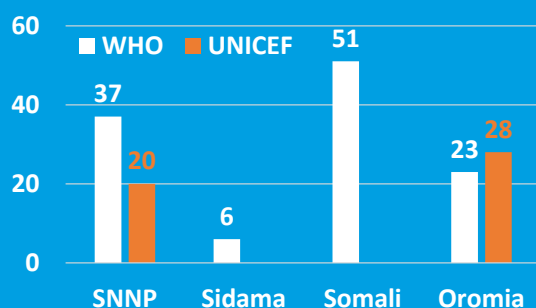
Daily cholera cases by region as of 25 June 2023



Response

- Second cross-border coordination meeting planned for 5 July 2023 between Ethiopia, Somalia, and Kenya under the auspices of the **Intergovernmental Authority on Development (IGAD)**.
- EPHI submitted request for additional Oral Cholera Vaccines (OCV) for further vaccination, ideally synchronized with Kenya and Somalia.
- Additional efforts are ongoing to engage with development partners for improving water supply systems, particularly in cholera hotspot woredas where the population relies on untreated river or pond water, and woredas with high rates of open defecation.

Malaria

Cases as of 25 June 2023	1,251,910
Weekly increase since 18 June 2023	78,993
Deaths	123
CFR	0.01% (-)
Woredas affected	912 (↑)

Highlights

- Increase of 16 woredas reporting at least one confirmed case of malaria since 18 June 2023, and 12 new deaths reported from Oromia (10), Benishangul Gumuz (1), and Gambella (1) regions.
- Gambella region continues to report the highest number of malaria cases (557 per 100,000 population in the week between 19 and 25 June 2023 as compared to 643 in the preceding week).

Response

- Reports of lack of malaria supplies, including Rapid Diagnostics Kits and bednets. WHO dispatched a malaria treatment kit to one health partner in Gambella.

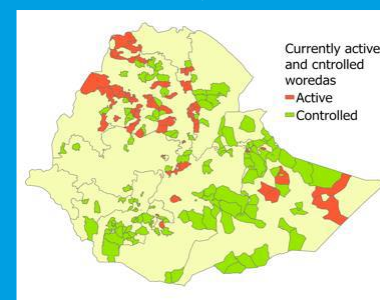
Measles

Cases as of 25 June 2023	21,739
Weekly increase since 18 June 2023	794
Deaths	220
CFR	1.01% (↓)
Woredas affected	58 (↑)

Highlights

- Increase of 3 woredas reporting measles cases since 18 June 2023.
- 44% of affected woredas and 91% of newly reported cases last week from Amhara region.

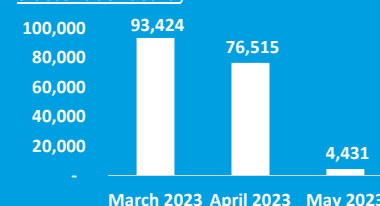
Woredas with active and controlled measles outbreaks up to 25 June 2023



Response

- Health partners are supporting with outbreak vaccination campaigns to address the suboptimal vaccination rates (see graph on the right): over 50% of children younger than 5 infected with measles are not vaccinated.
