The Monitoring and Evaluation Officer of the District Health Management Team (DHMT) in Moyamba district has disclosed that about 20 people have died from the cholera outbreak in the district since 25 July this year.

Speaking at a sensitization meeting organized by the Social Mobilization Coordinator of the DHMT, Kemah stated that a total of 392 cases were reported in the district including 111 which affected under-5 children.
